





## Step 1: Spanish Lesson: Numbers 1-10



## **Step-by-Step Guide:**

1. Prepare to teach numbers 1-10 by watching me teach the numbers in the video below. You'll see how I first have my students count to ten in English, and then we gradually count in Spanish along with a song as I point to the numbers.

New to Spanish? No problem—the video and song will do most of the teaching for you as you learn to count along with your students.

You can also start by **showing your students the video** on a tablet, iPad, TV, Smartboard, etc. **allowing me to teach numbers 1-10** for you. Or you can **skip to Activity 2** below and dive right into teaching the numbers yourself.

2. Click the blue "Click!" button below to download the **Number Poster** and to play the **Number Song** if for your students. As the number song is playing, **use** a fun wand or pointer to point to each number on the poster. Worried about pronunciation? Don't be! Just follow the pronunciation guide under each number on the poster. Read the pronunciation guide like you would English, and you'll sound like a pro in Spanish! Play the song multiple times and encourage your students to sing along.

Extra Special: Let students take turns being your helper and using a special wand to point to the numbers on the poster as everyone sings. This is a fun, interactive way to learn numbers as a class in Spanish!









I've provided you with the visuals to design a **Spanish bulletin board.** Place one at the entrance of your school and one in every classroom. **As soon as it's up, you can point to it while playing the number song and reviewing counting in Spanish,** making learning **interactive and visual** for your students.




## Step 3: Keep Families in the Loop
